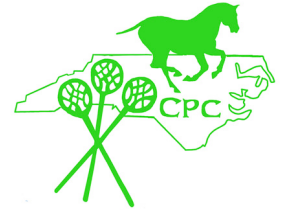

**Divisions:** A, B, C, D, E Masters/ Ladies Full 6 person teams (or we will adjust as necessary) \*

E grade will be Walk/Trot for beginners

Prizes for First and Second and entry gift. Extra gifts available to purchase at registration.

**Fees:**

APA Members	\$100
Junior Player fee (under 16 yr old)	\$ 85

**Stabling:**

On site stabling available, \$60 for weekend

The park checks **every stall** and will charge for every stall being used.

Bedding/shavings must be pre-ordered/paid, \$6 per bag. Stalls must be totally stripped

**Paddocks will be assigned to each club to share within your club and must be stripped clean** at the end of the weekend

All Paddock reservations and payment will be done in advance. Sarah Desai will be sending email and coordinating.

Daily ship in fee is \$10 per day and will be collected at registration.

Manure receptacles are placed near every barn and are for shavings and manure only.

Please park next to the barns to keep traffic down near the fields.

No RV hook ups and **DO NOT** plug trailers into barn outlets!

## General Tournament Info:

1. **No riding on the golf course or race track at any time. Violators will be asked to leave and charged a fee.** Only cross the track at ramp by barn 10 with vehicles. Horses may cross at opening by barn 9 or ramp by barn 10.
2. **Horses must be kept in stalls or paddocks overnight. No electric pens, tie lines, etc... allowed. Please post a stall card with Owners information in case of emergency.**
3. Limited showers available on site.
4. Arrival no earlier than May 24th. Departure no later than May 28th. Arrivals and/or later departures must be coordinated with the tournament secretary in advance. Lauren Ellis polocrosseurl@yahoo.com
5. **Umpire Horses:** Each team will need to provide a suitable umpire horse for their assigned games. Please include the name of the umpire horse(s) for your team with your entry form.
6. **Goal Tenders:** Teams will also need to provide at least one adult goal tender or one junior accompanied by an adult per game.

## **NOTES**

1. Send your Coggins or bring to registration. All horses must have a current Coggins, in accordance with NC statutes – **No Exceptions.** NAME ON COGGINS MUST BE SAME AS NAME OF HORSE PLAYING IN TOURNAMENT AND LISTED ON THIS REGISTRATION FORM. Scan and send to secretary now [polocrosseurl@yahoo.com](mailto:polocrosseurl@yahoo.com) If for some reason, you cannot email, you must bring your coggins to the registration table.
2. APA approved Helmets (per the APA rulebook) and appropriate footwear must be worn **at all times when mounted - No Exceptions.**
3. Underage drinking **WILL NOT** be tolerated in accordance with APA policies and NC statutes.
4. Tournament committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.
5. Non-APA members may play but must pay the additional APA day membership fee of \$30.00 or \$20.00 for Junior
6. Please stay off the tracks.
7. Entry fee includes dinner and gift for players only, additional gifts available for purchase. Additional dinners are available and **must be paid for in advance \$20/person**
8. Trash cans are provided for trash. Please dispose of trash properly in cans provided or in dumpsters.
9. Do not block any road or barn entrance with personal vehicles or trailers.
10. All pets must be on a leash or in a kennel area at all times. **That means NOT loose.** If your dog is seen running loose on the grounds there is a **\$50 fine!!!!**
11. Smoking in the stables/stable areas (within 25 feet) is not permitted.
12. Open fires are not permitted.
13. The grounds will officially open at 1:00 p.m. on Thursday, May 24th. The grounds will close at 1:00 PM on Monday, May 28. **Any early arrivals and/or late departures must notify the tournament secretary in advance.** [polocrosseurl@yahoo.com](mailto:polocrosseurl@yahoo.com)
14. APA players with current ratings should provide their ratings on the entry form. Teams will be placed in a division based on total Team rating. If there are any questions about this the tournament committee will be available for discussion on a case-by-case basis. Decisions of the tournament committee with respect to assigning teams to divisions are final.

15. Tournament committee reserves the right to reassign teams or individuals to divisions (move them up or down) as required. Tournament committee reserves the right to refuse any entry.

17. Stalls must be totally stripped. Paddocks need to be picked out and hay needs to be removed. All manure and old hay needs to be dumped in the manure receptacles around each barn. Please pick manure up from around your trailers as well. There is a \$25 fee for every pile of manure left around the barn

### **Directions:**

• *From the North:* US 1 or US 15-501, exit at Morganton Rd in Southern Pines, turn right (west) toward Pinehurst. Follow Morganton to end, turn left (south) on NC 5. Entrance on left.

• *From the West:* Take US 220 (I-73/74 corridor) to NC 211 east toward Pinehurst. Turn right at NC5, Harness Track is 1.7 mi. on left.

• *From South:* US 1 to Aberdeen, turn left (west) on NC 5 to Harness Track, approx. 5 miles on right.
